- 1851- JEWISH BENEVOLENT SOCIETY organized
- 1853- Nashville's first Rabbi, Alexander Lser, arrives from NY
- 1854- "MOGEL DAVID" Congregation organized in 1854
- 1862- DEN YESHURUN congregation founded in 1862
- 1868- KKOS organized in 1868
- 1870- VINE ST TEMPLE built 1870
- 1874- CORNERSTONE LAID IN 1874
- 1901- KKSI built 1901
- 1920- KKSI built 1920
